

## English Language Proficiency Requirements

Listed below are the English language proficiency requirements for entry **for domestic and international applicants** to programs (with the exception of enabling programs) at the University of Newcastle.

The University of Newcastle has developed a [visual representation](#) of how to decide if you meet the **English Language Requirements for Admission** – you will need to read that document in conjunction with the below tables.

Applicants must provide evidence of English language proficiency through one of the following methods:

1. Minimum proficiency test results as outlined in Tables 1a to 1c below. English language test scores must be less than 2 years old at the date of application to the University of Newcastle.

For other English tests accepted by the University, please refer to **Table 5 - English language skills tests concordance table** to convert the IELTS requirement to TOEFL PB (Paper-based), TOEFL IBT (Internet-based test), PTE (Pearsons Test of English), Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE) and Cambridge English: Proficiency (CPE).
