Sample Questions for Use in an Oral Examination (Viva)

Some questions that may be suitable for the Oral Examination (Viva) include:

- 1. Your answer to question number "X", [read the text of the question] was quite [brief/confusing/unexpected/interesting] could you please explain what aspects of the course you drew on to arrive at this answer?
- 2. Could you please explain how you arrived at the answer to question "X", [read the text of the question]?
- 3. You answered question "X", [read the text of the question] by [read the answer]. What do you think you could add to this to improve your answer?
- 4. Your answer to question "X" is unusual because it [doesn't match other answers you have given/was not covered in the course/uses a different approach to what we covered in the course] could you please tell us how you came to this [answer/response].
