	Blended	Content is delivered asynchronously online via LMS (e.g. videos, readings, podcasts, etc), and students attend on campus labs, tutorials, workshops, etc. for active learning. Note: Content delivery will usually occur online, with active learning sessions being face to face. Mode does allow flexibility for this to be reversed.	No	No	Yes	Yes
	Simultaneous	All sessions both content delivery <b>and</b> active learning are delivered both on campus and online simultaneously. Students must attend one in person session each week.	Flexible (space & delivery must be appropriate for high quality simultaneous online participation)	Yes	Flexible (space & delivery must be appropriate for high quality simultaneous online participation)	Yes
Online	Synchronous Online	Content is delivered online via LMS (e.g. videos, readings, podcasts, etc), and students attend timetabled online sessions (e.g. scheduled group calls, webinars, etc).	No	No	No	Yes
	Asynchronous Online	Content is delivered online via LMS (e.g. videos, readings, podcasts, etc), and students engage with content via untimetable online learning activities.	No	No	No	No
	Online with Intensive	Content is delivered online via LMS (e.g. videos, readings, podcasts, etc), and students engage with content via untimetable online learning activities. Students must attend campus for scheduled (not weekly) face to face intensive sessions.	No	No	Yes (not weekly, scheduled intensives)	Yes (not weekly, scheduled intensives)
