

# Copyright Warning Notices Guidelines

- (1) What copyright warning notices must be given when copying or communicating electronically?
- (2) The Digital Agenda amendments to the [Copyright Act 1968](#) impose strict obligations on universities to bring copyright obligations to the attention of staff and students.
- (3) Each licensed electronic copy and licensed communication **MUST** contain the following prominently displayed electronic notice:
