## Section 1 - Transfer of Students

- g. Bachelor of Midwifery
- h. Bachelor of Nursing

## Section 3 - Grading of Associate Degree

(4) The Associate Degree in Health will be conferred as an ordinary Associate Degree.

## Section 4 - Re-Admission and/or Re-Enrolment into Original Program

(5) Students awarded the Associate Degree in Health will not be permitted to re-enrol or be re-admitted to their original program of study, except under exceptional circumstances approved by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic) and Vice President and on recommendation of the Pro Vice-Chancellor College of Health, Medicine and Wellbeing.

## Glossary Terms and Definitions

**"Student"** - A person formally enrolled in a course or active in a program offered by the University or affiliated entity.

**"Exit award"** - An academic qualification that is conferred when a student has met the program requirements of a linked program within the same field of study as listed in the relevant Awards and Programs Schedule.

**"Program"** - When referring to learning, a program is a sequence of approved learning, usually leading to an Award. For all other uses of this term, the generic definition applies.
